ORCID at Charles University

ORCID ("Open Researcher and Contributor IDentifier") is a unique, permanent and internationally recognised **identifier of persons** involved in research and publication processes in scholarship. The creation and use of an ORCID iD allows authors from Charles University to **unambiguously connect to and identify their publications**, **research data and other results** of scholarly activity.

Authors from Charles University are obliged to enter ORCID iD and other scholarly identifiers into the IS Věda system under Article 19 (1) of te <u>Directive on the Registration of Creative Activities</u>. In order to facilitate the automated transfer of authors' publishing activities to their ORCID profiles, Charles University has prepared a system for the direct **integration of ORCID and the OBD: IS Věda module**.
