# Synchronisation of ORCID iD and Researcher IDs

Researcher ID is an author identifier recorded in the **Web of Science database**. It is linked to WoS records and offers a variety of related reports and metrics, a record of reviews, and the author's editorial work. Authors create a Researcher ID profile on their own or with the help of a faculty coordinator.

It is possible to set up the mutual synchronisation of records between the Researcher ID and the ORCID iD. Synchronisation instructions:

1) Select the blue highlighted text "enabling ORCiD import sync in your profile settings" in the Researcher profile ID settings under "Sync with ORCID".




