


<u>CrossRef</u> is an international agency that provides infrastructure for DOI (Digital Object Identifier) in the field of **scholarly publishing**. It is a database of **all DOIs issued by the agency**.

## **ORCID iD and CrossRef synchronisation**

1) In the ORCID profile, scroll down to the Works section and use the "Add" instruction to make a selection via "Search & link".








2) In the selection, click on CrossRef Metadata Search.



3) A new tab will open in which you will be prompted to sign in to ORCID.



4) In the next step, you allow CrossRef to access your ORCID account and add records. To enable this, click on Authorize access.

- In the search box, enter your name or another identifier that you use when publishing for example, ORCID iD.
