



ORCID iD and DataCite synchronisation

1) In your ORCID profile, scroll down to the Works section and use the "Add" instruction to make a selection via "Search & link".





4) In the next step, you allow DataCite to access your ORCID account and add records. To enable this, click on Authorize access.

- **6)** After synchronisation has been set up the <u>DataCite Commons</u> page, which you can use to add existing records to your ORCID profile, opens automatically.
- On the DataCite Commons page you can search for records with your name or ORCID iD (the page automatically displays the search according to ORCID iD when opened). Find the record you want to add to your ORCID account in the list and click on its name.


