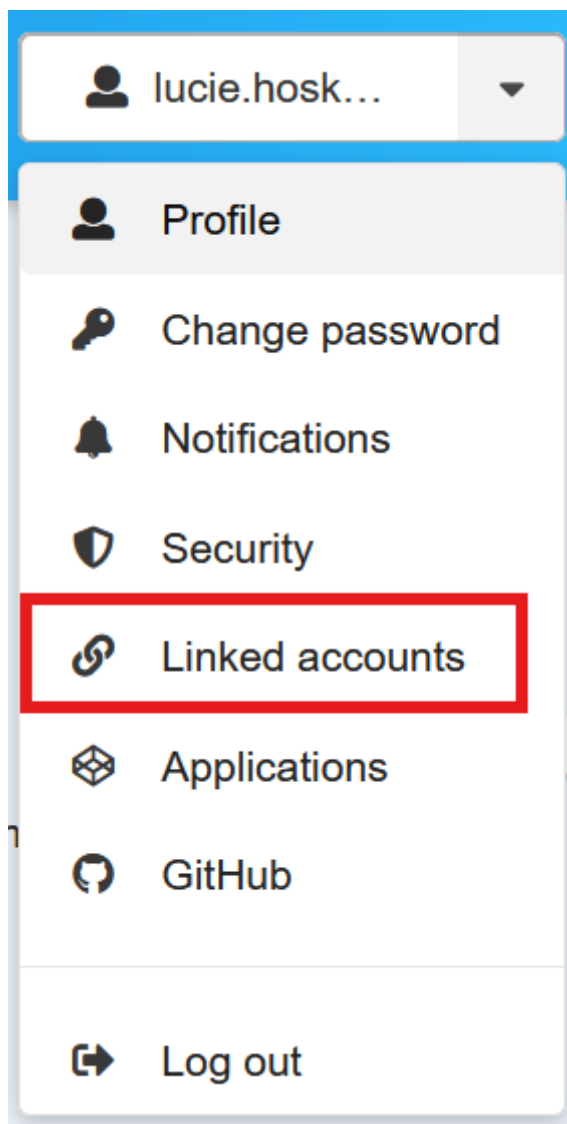

Zenodo

Transcribing ORCID iD into Zenodo records

1) Open the "**Linked accounts**" section of your Zenodo profile.



2) For ORCID, click on Connect.
